

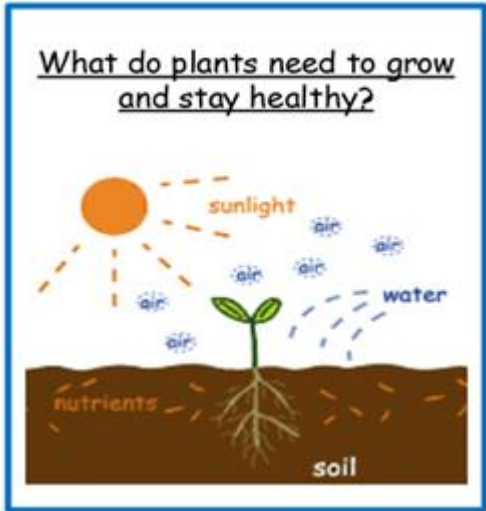


Seeds only grow into a new plant **once.**

| Spelling | Definition |
| plant | A living thing that grows in the ground. It usually has leaves or flower and needs sun and water to survive. |
| seed | Are the small parts produced by plants which grow into new plants. |
| seedling | A young plant or tree grown from a seed. |
| bulb | A rounded part of a plant from which a stem and roots grow. |
| trunk | The main stem of a tree from which its branches and roots grow. |
| grow | Increasing in size and changing physically in a natural way. |
| growth | Occurs as the stems and root get longer. |
| healthy | Means that something is in a good physical condition free from disease. |
| survival | Staying alive and not dying. |
| conditions | What a plant needs to grow and stay healthy. |
| temperature | How hot or cold an object or person is. |
| mature | A fully grown or old plant. |
