Spelling	Definition	Spelling	Definition
Bending	Change a straight object so it is curved.	Materials	What something is made from e.g. wood, plastic, metal.
Squashing	Crush an object so it changes shape.	Property	How you describe a material e.g. rough, smooth, hard.
Twisting	Change the shape of an object by turning it.	Multiple	More than one.
Stretching	Making an object longer or wider, without it breaking.	Waterproof	Does not absorb water.
Man-made	Made by a human. Not natural.	Absorbent	Let's water in.
Natural	Not made by a human, found in nature.	Suitable	Right for what it is being used for.

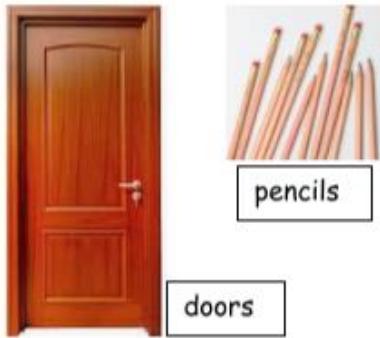
