

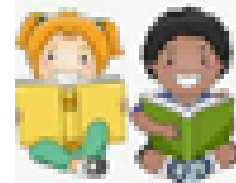

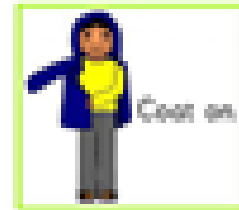

- Count out an amount from a group (can you get 5 oranges).

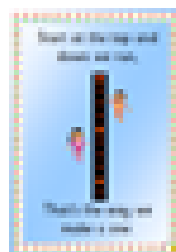
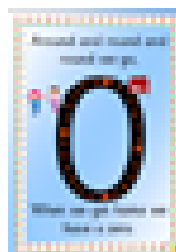
Please make sure you have these items in school every day...
