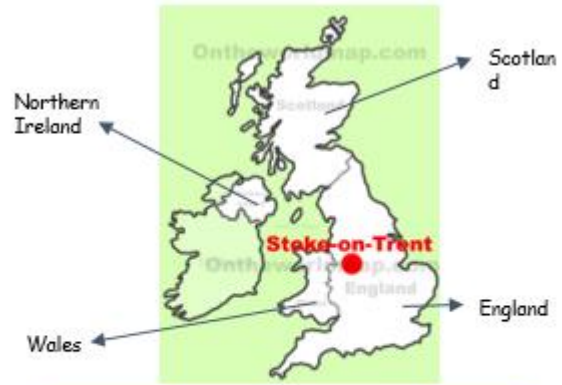

<u>Spelling</u>	<u>Definition</u>
Human feature	Features in an area that a human has built or put there e.g. roads, houses and bus stop.
City	A City is larger than a town. It is where people live and work.
Town	A town is smaller than a City. It is also an area where people live and work, but it is surrounded by a rural area.
Field	An area of open land, often planted with crops (food), bounded by a hedge or a fence.
Physical feature	Features in an area that are natural. A human did not build these e.g. rivers, hills and mountains.
Forest	A large area covered mainly with trees and undergrowth.
Hill	A naturally raised area of land, not as high as a mountain.
Mountain	A large natural raised area, rising steeply from the surrounding area.
River	A large natural stream of water flowing into the sea, a lake or another river.
Rural	A characteristic of the countryside.
Urban	A characteristic of a town or city.
Landmark	An object or feature of an area that is easily seen and recognised from a distance.

An _____ area is a town or a city, therefore there are a lot of houses, shops and other buildings. There are not as many trees, fields or forests in urban areas.
