Key Vocabulary

Climate	The average weather in a place over many of years.
Conquer	To successfully overcome something.
Denmark	This is a Scandinavian country where the capital city is Copenhagen.
Geographical location	The position on the Earth by using the coordinates longitude and latitude.
Human features	Landmarks that are built by humans, also known as 'man made'.
Invaders	A person or group who attacks a place that isn't theirs.
Kingdom	A country ruled by a King or Queen.
Norway	Is a Scandinavian country surrounded by mountains, glaciers and fjords. The capital city is Oslo.
Physical features	Landmarks that are formed naturally such as glaciers, fjords, waterfalls, mountains and lakes.
Region	A particular area or part of the world, into which a country is divided because of its human and physical features.
Scandinavia	A region in Europe made of 3 different countries (Sweden, Norway & Denmark).
Sweden	A country in Scandinavia where the capital city is Stockholm.
