*My favourite memory at Forest Park was the camping experiment because I've never had so much fun without touching a device and we learnt so many new things.*




*My favourite memory at Forest Park was the Monkey Forest trip in year 2 because we got to learn about different types of animals and it was so much fun.*

*I love Forest Park because they give us so many experiences. I remember when we went to Stanley Head in Year 4 and we learnt how to build dens and light a fire.*




*My favourite memory at Forest park is in Year 3 when we went on the Stone Age trip because it taught me about the importance of team work through building dens.*

*My favourite memory at Forest Park was in Nursery, when me and Sami would play outside on our bikes. I knew from that moment how happy I was going to be at Forest Park!*




*I remember the Victorian time in year 4 it was so fun and I learnt so much about life in the past.*

*I have loved all the P.E lessons at Forest Park especially with Tom. We got to learn so many new skills.*




*Thank you to Mrs

how to ride a bike.*




