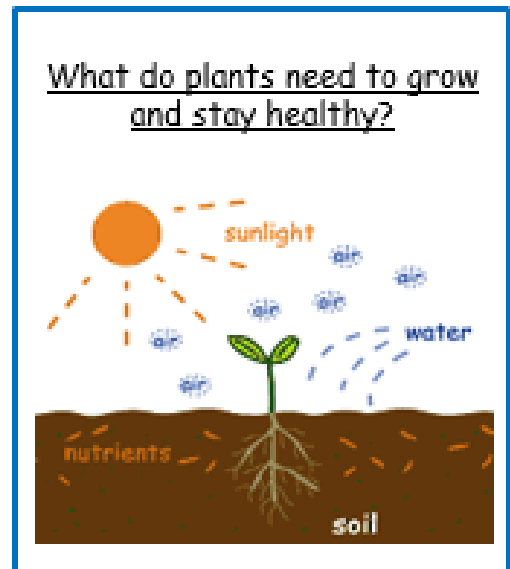
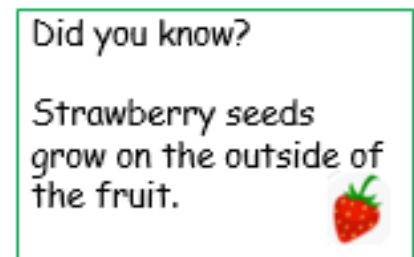

Spelling	Definition
plant	A living thing that usually grows from the ground.
seed	Grows into a new plant by reproduction. Will only grown into a plant once.
bulb	A round underground storage organ that grows into a new plant in the Spring after lying dormant over winter.
trunk	The main woody stem of a tree from which its branches and roots grow.
grow	Increasing in size and changing physically in a natural way.
growth	Growth in plants occurs as the stems and roots lengthen.
healthy	Healthy means that something is in a good physical condition free from disease.
survival	A plant needs certain conditions to survive and grow into a healthy plant.
conditions	The conditions that a plant is kept can affect how healthy that plant will be.
temperature	How hot or cold an object or person is.
mature	When a plant is fully grown, we can say that the plant is mature or old.
