

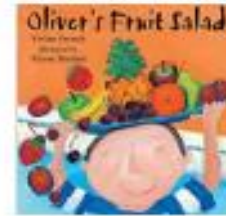


Year 1 Knowledge Organiser - Autumn 2

<u>Vocabulary Dozen</u>	
Guy Fawkes 	13 April 1570 - 31 January 1606 He was a member of a group of Catholics who planned the failed Gunpowder Plot of 1605.
Remembrance 	A day to remember the members of the armed forces who have died in the line of duty.
Church	The religious building Christians worship in.
Sense	We have 5 senses that help us understand our world.
Herbivore	An animal that gets its energy from eating plants, and only plants.
Carnivore	An animal that gets food from killing and eating other animals.
Omnivore	An animal that has the ability to eat and survive on both plants and animals.
Amphibian	Small cold blooded vertebrates that need water to survive. This group include frogs, toads and newts
Bird	A warm-blooded egg-laying vertebrate animal usually has feathers, wings, a beak, and typically able to fly. This group includes robins, ducks and flamingos.
Mammal	A warm-blooded vertebrate animal that usually has hair or fur and (typically) the birth of live young. This group includes humans, cats and lions.
Fish	A cold-blooded vertebrate animal with gills and fins living wholly in water. This group includes tuna, sharks and goldfish
Reptile	A vertebrate that has a dry scaly skin and typically lays soft-shelled eggs on land. Includes snakes, lizards and crocodiles.
