1. **Draw** the biggest number (Tens and ones)
2. **Subtract the ones** (remember if there are not enough ones in the ones column, you need to **EXCHANGE** one ten for ten ones).
4. **Next**, subtract the tens.
5. **Answer** = How many tens? How many ones?

 - b) $65 - 45 =$
 - c) $20 - 12 =$
 - d) $47 - 18 =$
 - e) $30 - 10 =$
 - f) $99 - 47 =$
 - g) $46 - 45 =$
 - h) $60 - 50 =$

- 5) Exercise is important to keep our bodies healthy. Can you list **five 'active' exercises** that you could do at home and five 'inactive' exercises that you should do less of.
