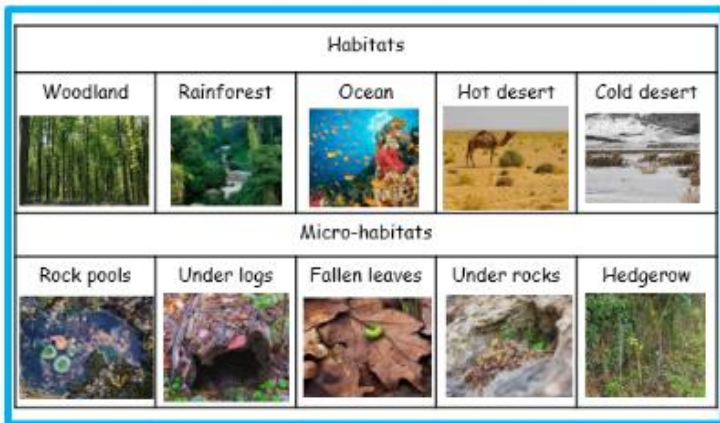

Spelling	Definition	Spelling	Definition
Alive	Something that is living can move, breath, reproduce, excrete, needs food and is sensitive to light .	Nutrition	Eating the correct food for health and growth.
Dead	Something that is no longer alive.	Growth	Increasing in size in a natural way.
Never been alive	Something that has never lived eg. a stone or a toy.	Reproduce	To produce offspring.
Habitat	The place where an animal or plant lives. It gives them food, water, air and shelter.	Predator	An animal that catches and eats other animals (the prey).
Micro-habitat	A small habitat that is part of a larger habitat.	Prey	An animal that is killed and eaten by another animal (called a predator).
Environment	Includes the air, water and land where animals and plants live.	Movement	An act of moving.
