Bending	Change a straight object so it is curved.
Squashing	Crush something so that it changes shape.
Twisting	Change the shape of something by turning it.
Stretching	Make longer or wider without breaking it.
Man-made	Made by a human, not natural.
Natural	Not made by a human, found in nature.
Suitable	Right for what it is being used for.
Materials	What something is made from e.g. wood, plastic, metal.
Property	What a material is like e.g. rough, smooth, hard.
Multiple	More than one.
Waterproof	Does not let water in.
Absorbent	Lets water in.
